Next, answer the following questions:

1. What do you enjoy doing the most and why?
2. What don't you enjoy doing and why?
3. What are your career aspirations and what steps do you need to take to get there?
4. What other options are available to you – do you want to work in a different industry, would another industry be better suited to your career objectives?
5. What are your income needs and expectations? Are they realistic?
6. What do you look for in an employer – what do you value in the company that you work for?

Sometimes, it is difficult to answer these questions on your own. It is a good idea to talk to a mentor, your manager, industry bodies/ representatives or an industry specialist recruiter.

Equipped with these answers, you should have some clues or areas of interest to pursue.

Step 2 - Consider Your Options

The next step is to identify how you might be able to find such a job. Keep in mind your objective is to find the right job, with the right company, which will give you the opportunity to add value to the company and achieve your personal goals.

There are many options available to find employment:

- Word of Mouth & Referral
- Newspaper Advertisements
- Internet Job Board Advertisements

- Networking through Industry Groups, Institutes, Universities, Business Groups
- Employment Agency Representation

Research all options and establish a plan of action. The internet is a very useful tool to research companies, jobs, recruiters and industry groups.

Choosing An Employment Agency

An employment agency can help you considerably if you choose the right one and establish a good working relationship with your consultant. In choosing an agency or recruitment consultant, it is important that you ensure they are the right agency or consultant to help you.
